Notes from India

Praise the Lord – the case against Jay has been 95% resolved! Thank you for your prayers on Jay's behalf. The man who accused Jay of forced conversion has repented and asked for forgiveness. He also went to the authorities and told them in writing that the charges were false. We are waiting for all the paper work to be completed and the charges formally dropped.

Thank you for everyone who has contributed to the security wall around our compound in Damoh. The wall/fence has been completed and it is such a blessing for all the students, faculty, and those who live and work there.



Persecution Continues

Thank you for your prayers concerning the elections in India. Persecution continues against all Christians in many states.

Many have asked about the state of Orissa (to the east of Chhattisgarh, on the Bay of Bengal). Conditions there are not good. Extremists have threatened Christians, burned their homes,



and attacked and burned churches. Christians had an even tougher time during the Christmas Holidays. Extremists created difficulties

so that Christians were not able to celebrate Christmas Day or worship together. Churches were attacked and manger scenes destroyed. We estimate that thousands of Christians were forced to flee their homes. As they fled, criminals looted their homes, churches, and institutions and then burned whatever was left. There is little relief work going on in the resulting refugee camps. Outsiders are not permitted to do relief work in this area at the present time.



In one state to our south, several Christians, returning home after a Christmas gathering, were attacked and beaten with sticks.

It is not safe for Christians to gather in public for worship or study in many places.
