News from India

Excerpt from recent email received from Jay Henry:

"We also thank you for the prayers on our behalf. It seems that there is no end to the pressure that is on us and the mission these days [we expect it to be for another 4 years, in one way or another]. The enquiries are of such a nature that it eats up all our time preparing answers. Some are purposely given so that we are at the corner to find answers in a very short time. Like ALL records of the mission since it was started. That means going back to 1969-70 and dig for the papers [there were no computers then] many of which, at least portions, have been eaten up by time, dust and bugs. There are other similar harassing queries that come up every now and then. We all are putting our heads together to solve all this, sometimes with the help of a lawyer.

The work, however, continues. The classes at the college are very regular. The students are just asked to pray without giving them any details. But yes, we do need prayers, not just for us, but for those who are playing in the hands of the power of darkness."

News from the States

Wow, thank you for all of the Christmas offerings and gifts to purchase goats and sewing machines. We received over \$8,000 from churches and individuals. Jay and Ernest are in the process of buying the sewing machines and goats and distributing them. Next newsletter, we hope to have some pictures of those who received them.

We are over the \$610,000 mark toward reaching our \$650,000 capital campaign goal. Construction will soon start on the Pendra Project.
